5 Practical Steps

- Know the methods being used on your samples
 - Is the method applicable to sample types?
 - What is the sample prep being used?
 - Is the lab prepping the samples? If so, how?
 - Is the plant prepping the samples? If so, how?
- What are their Certifications & Accreditations?
 - What is their QA program?



□ 5 Practical Steps (cont.)

- Push your labs to be enrolled in PT programs
 - Ensure the PTs are specific to your sample types
 - ASTM DDGS Proficiency Testing
 - AOCS DDGS Proficiency Testing
 - AAFCO PT are great, but not specific to our industry
 - What do they do with the results?
 - As an industry, we need them to mean something.



- □ 5 Practical Steps (cont.)
 - Don't be afraid to send blind repeats
 - Communicate if they fail and ask for a CAR (Corrective Action Report)
 - Ask Questions



Your 3rd Party Contract Laboratory should be your partner and viewed as an extension of your business, so hold them accountable.
