



REPURPOSING ASSETS - CAMILLA, GEORGIA

Southwest Georgia Ethanol (FUEL)


- Opened in 2008 120M gallon capacity
- 310,000 tons of DDGs and 21M pounds of corn oil
- Acquired by Flint Hills (Koch) in 2015

Permanently Closed in 2020

- Previously idled during COVID
- Access to competitively priced corn remained an ongoing challenge

Repurposed by POET in 2021

- Part of a larger deal with Flint Hills
- Now receiving DDGs and ethanol
